Are You Registered to Vote?

Some startling facts:

- ◆ 15-20 million Christians are not even registered to vote. That's about 20% not registered.
- ♦ Key states in the 2008 election were won by a smaller margin than the number of unregistered Christians in those states.
- ♦ 537 votes in Florida in 2000 actually determined the outcome of the national election.
- ◆ In 2000, 76% of the citizens of the US were registered to vote. Only 51.3% actually voted.
- ◆ The Christian community could determine almost any election anywhere in the nation if they would simply vote.

If you have moved since the last election, check to see if you are registered to vote in your precinct. Forms for voter registration can be found online. Just Google "voter registration [your state] form". Completed forms must be postmarked by October 9, 2012, in Indiana. Deadlines for other states may vary.



Operation Christmas Child

For the past 9 years FMC has collected shoeboxes filled with gifts that are distributed to children in desperate situations worldwide. There are brochures at the Connec-



tion Center. If you would rather not fill a box yourself and would like to make a donation, the money will be used to fill boxes and cover the shipping - just mark your offering envelope "shoeboxes". The suggested donation is \$30 per box. As soon as you have a shoebox filled - you may drop it off at the connection center - the **deadline is Sunday, November 4** to have **700 shoeboxes** ready to go! If you have extra shoeboxes stashed at home and would like to donate them for this use, please drop them off at the Connection Center. The plastic ones (shoebox sized) with lids work very well also.



An Opportunity to Fight World Poverty and Spread the Gospel

FMC likes to do its small part to fight world poverty and present the gospel while doing so. We have been asked to partner with Solar Clutch of Fort Wayne and Disciple Makers from Somalia who are working in an underground church in the horn of Africa. The Disciple Makers are converts from Islam in a refugee camp of 1,500 people.

Solar Clutch makes solar cookers - the cookers are made in Fort Wayne and used around the world with outreach projects. Fellowship Missionary Church in Fort Wayne partners with this group. It is all run by World Partners missionaries. World Partners is the overseas missions arm of the Missionary Church. The goal is \$6,000 or any part of it we can provide. Next week, October 14, we will have a special opportunity to partner with Solar Clutch.



The new van/utility truck project

is back on the top of the needs lists. Total cost \$35,000 - Project Help has agreed to pay half of it because they use it almost as much as we do.

The old van has only gotten worse since we started this project in the spring of 2012. The tires are balder, the rust is bigger, the muffler system is louder. Those who use it are praying harder that it makes it back home! Above is a picture of something similar to what we pray to purchase. Presently we have \$5,180 toward our half of the purchase price.



BMP News

Bethlehem Marketplace (BMP) is only 8 weeks away! Sign up begins October 21.

2012 marks our 23rd year. There is a booklet in the literature rack that explains this Bridge Event ministry and why we do it.

- 1. December 1 and 2, 2012, 1:00 to 5:00 pm each day.
- 2. Be in prayer for your participation. Be in prayer for the 3,000+ that God will bring to experience what the streets of Bethlehem the day after Christ was born, must have been like.
- 3. Publicity is available at the bulletin table in the foyer. Take all you can use. Publicity is produced right here in the office and we can run more anytime.
- 4. If you or anyone you know is getting carpet in the next 2 months we would welcome your old carpet. The streets of BMP are covered with sand over the carpet.
- 5. This year there will be an emphasis on the ministry of FMC during the music and at the end of the streets. Approximately 3,000+ people come through the streets each year and 75% are first-timers. The prayer and goal is to help them become first time and regular attenders on Sunday mornings too.
- 6. If you are looking for a ministry opportunity we are seeking a carpenter to make a new well out of Styrofoam and plywood. Contact Pastor Norm.
- 7. We are seeking people whose first contact with FMC was BMP. We would like to use you in a promotional video (not the same ones we used last year.) Contact the office, 665-8402.
