


January 27, 2013, Survey Results

FMC does its small part to help fight world poverty. One of the ways we do this is through the Leap of Faith store in the Brick House Design Studio in downtown Fremont (next to Edward Jones). Stop in and find items from third world countries. Your purchase helps put food on the table for a family. The store is closed Sunday and Monday.

The coffee at the donut tables in the foyer today and for several weeks, comes from the store. It is Equal Exchange coffee where the grower gets paid a fair wage to support his family. Please tell the FMC office in a written note how you like the coffee.

The Next Step Committee would like to thank you for your continued support in providing no interest loans to micro enterprises all around the world. We were able to finance loans in Kenya and Zambia with your generous contributions. With your continued support, we will be able to continue to help those in poverty help themselves in the name of Jesus.

Julius Ng'Ang'A Muhia - Age 44 Occupation: Wholesale Supplies Amount Requested: \$1,120.00

Julius lives in Eastleigh (close to Nairobi) with his wife and 3 children. Their biggest challenge is maintaining enough income for the basic needs of their home. Their biggest priority is to pay the school fees for their children.



Julius was able to start his first business after selling his cow several years ago. Since that time, he has operated a variety of small shops along the road selling products he feels are in demand. His goal is to eventually have a stable enough business to be recognized by the City Council and be able to operate in a solid building downtown in Nairobi. He is confident that through working with Missions of Hope, he will be able to make that dream a reality.

Sunday, March 3, 2013, has been designated "Give it all away Sunday" at FMC. That Sunday we are going to give away our entire offering. We are not paying utilities, not paying the mortgage, not even salaries. (Those have all been taken care of.) Instead, the Church Leadership Board has declared it "give it all away Sunday". We are going to give it away globally, nationally, regionally and locally.

Globally - we are going to help fight world poverty by funding the Kids Against Hunger meal packing event. Some of it will go to spread the gospel into lands where the good news has seldom or never gone through World Partners and through our missionaries George and Karen Bellas with their internet outreach to Muslims. Thousands have come to know the Lord through this internet outreach into closed countries. Our missionaries in Brazil touch young lives by teaching at the Pan American Christian Academy. Our missionaries studying in Ukraine welcome our giving it all away.

Nationally - we like to support the high-energy sports ministry of Uncharted Waters where our own Anna Flint serves, headquartered in Colorado Springs, Colorado. We also help support the Gideons ministry with Bibles in hotel rooms.

Regionally - Camp Selah is where our kids go to summer camp and lives are changed. They welcome our support. We will help other missionary churches in northern Indiana and southern Michigan through counseling and encouragement of their pastors with our District Office.

Locally - We will give it away to help the under resourced with basic needs through Project Help. We will give some away to help protect the unborn through Compassion Pregnancy Center. CEF reaches out to children, Youth for Christ of Northeast Indiana reaches out to area teens and Christian Campus House at Trine University reaches out to college students. We want to give it all away to them too.

Some Updates About The Strip Club

This is our understanding, the meeting on February 12th concerning city zoning and The Club does not allow for public comment. You are welcome to attend but there is no opportunity to talk. Everyone should be praying for clarity of thought and presentation for the city lawyer and for confusion and disarray for The Club's presenters. We are in a spiritual battle.

It is assumed that the judge hearing the case on the 12th will not make a ruling that day but will take everything under advisement and issue a ruling in a few weeks.

The meeting on February 12th has nothing to do with the alcohol permit denial - these are two separate issues. I have been in touch with Senator Susan Glick's office to find where we are in the process of reversing the State Board's decision to approve an alcohol permit. The time to receive letters of appeal has been closed. No letters concerning this issue are being accepted from this time on. Some time in the next two weeks or so the judge in Indianapolis will review all the letters received and determine if anyone has a case. If it is found by the judge that no one has legal standing to stop the issuance of the permit then an alcohol permit will be issued and there is no further appeal on this topic - case closed - decided as far as the State Alcohol Board is concerned.

If it is found that there is legal standing for not issuing a permit then an appeal date will be set where both sides will have opportunity to present facts and finding before a judge. If this meeting is granted, it will probably take place the end of February or the first week of March and individuals whose letters were instrumental in helping the judge see it correctly will be notified of the hearing by mail. Not everyone who sent a letter to the Board will receive notice - only those whose letters were accepted as legal standing to stop the permit will receive a notice.

Pray for this judge that he will have clear thinking and be able to see a community that has come together to say no to the alcohol permit for a strip club.

The real battle in the spiritual realm is taking place in these next few weeks. Thank you for your prayers.
