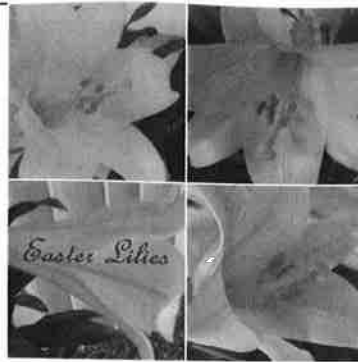


Easter Lilies
