
ATTENTION GRADUATES AND PARENTS


Mother's Day Services Note:

Why are we doing this?

So we can meet some of the practical needs of our community and provide opportunities for FMC people to use their practical gifts.

Who is the target group we will serve?

Anyone, but we do purposely look for serving opportunities that touch many lives and are community focused - things like: cleaning up city parks planting flowers on community property painting community buildings

We will help individuals too, raking leaves, shoveling snow, etc.

When are we going to do this?

The second Saturday of each month from 8 a.m. to noon beginning June 8; then July 13, August 10, etc.
