Where will we serve June 8th?



Update on Youth Pastor Search

They will be moving to our area from Washington State the week after Father's Day. It is a 40 hour drive. Their first day will be Sunday, June 23. We are excited for their arrival. This plan was approved by the Church Leadership Board before the announcement was made to the congregation. The transition plan will be completed sometime in 2015.


