

Guardians of teens and young adult children who have made negative life altering decisions and the whole family is now coping with the decisions. These negative events may have happened many years ago and you have found healing. These events may be happening right now and you are searching for answers.

This group that is meeting July 14th is not an "I have the answer" group, this is a one-time support group with the prayer that individuals in the group may connect with others for further support and encouragement.
