Having surgery? Contact the church office and a staff person will be there for your surgery to pray ahead of time and possibly to sit with your family while you are in surgery. Each individual family handles surgery and hospital stays differently. Some only want the pastoral staff to pray over the phone. We ask you to tell us what you want the pastoral staff to do and which staff person you prefer.

Small Churches - to get connected in a small church, start attending one at 9:00 or 10:30 am. It's very easy to get lost in the crowd if you do not connect in a Small Church.

Do you really use the information on the friendship pad? Yes! It is put into the computer by Stephance on Monday morning. Welcome letters to new attenders are done on Wednesday.

The church has a heart defibrillator and trained professionals for emergency medical needs during all services.

The church has a trained security team at all services. They walk the parking lot and church at all times to look for anything out of the ordinary.

Meals Ministry - If you are having surgery and could use help with meals once you are home - call the church ahead of time to make arrangements for meals to come 3 times a week for one or two weeks.

New Baby - When you have a new baby in the family, please call or e-mail the church office with the details so it can be announced in the bulletin. The Meals Ministry is also available for new moms!

Any **building maintenance** questions or if the doors won't lock; or if something is broken, leave a note at the Connection Center for our Facilities Manager, Mark Compton.

If you need to **reserve** a special room, bus, van or borrow tables or chairs from the church, contact the church office.


Coming this fall - Pastors Jake, Joel and Norm each teaching a Wednesday night class. Watch for details closer to the start date.
