

They were intended to go to a pastor in the Sudan. They never got sent. Why? The pastor was a converted Muslim but still dressed like a Muslim in order to reach his people for Christ. It turns out the pastor's brother is an extremist with Al-Qaeda and has threatened to kill his Christian brother if the pastor returns to the Sudan. The pastor is now in hiding in a different country.

Some of the solar cookers were sent to a camp for handicapped adults in Sudan. One of the adults is blind and had often burned her hand on the pots or fire as she cooked. She praised God for the technology of a solar cooker because she would no longer burn her hands testing how hot the pot was.
