But it is a very slow moving battle. Please pray that God would send His angels into the battle. This may be the last time I mention anything about this for a long time, until the victory is won, but don't stop praying because I certainly have not stopped fighting this.

"When is Pastor Norm retiring?"

There will be a distribution of duties to each staff member based on each person's giftedness. In the next year, Pastor Joel and Pastor Norm will share Sunday morning speaking responsibilities, alternating approximately every four weeks.


This is an entire church series with adults, teens and children all participating - adult small churches, the teen Sunday school class and children's classes are all following the same schedule.
