We seek people who have been in it all 24 years or people who were in it for the first time last year. Write a note to Pastor Norm or email him at norm@fairview-missionary.org.

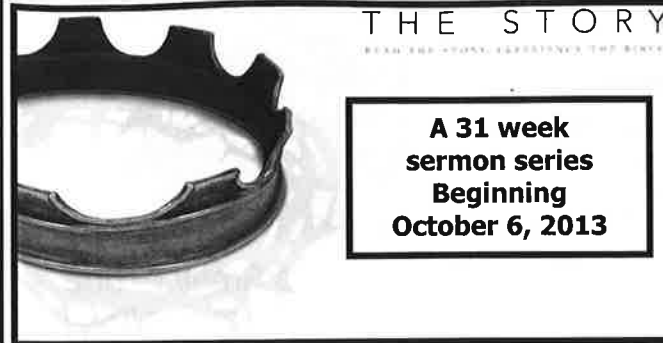
Publicity for BMP is at the south end of the foyer. Feel free to pick up all you can use.

Announcing "The Story"

Taking only Christmas Sunday and Mother's day away from the series, we will finish May 25, 2014. Pastor Joel and Pastor Norm will usually alternate four Sundays on and

four Sundays off in speaking during the series. We have chosen October 6 for the starting date because Easter 2014 will fall on Easter in the series.

Long time attenders will remember the *Walk Through the Bible* seminars at FMC in the 1990's. This series is like an expanded seminar - touching the main action and people of God in His story as he reveals himself to mankind and buys our salvation.
