## **Pastor Transition Update**

In November, 2012, Pastor Norm and Pastor Joel announced to the FMC congregation the beginning of a 2.5-3 year transition time where Pastor Norm would be stepping into a different role at FMC and Pastor Joel would become the lead pastor. Let us answer the most often asked questions since that announcement. This will be refined over the next year and a half but this is where it stands as of now. We say a huge **Thank You** for your prayers and support.

- 1. How is the transition going? It is going very, very well. The congregation overwhelmingly tells us that we are making the right decisions. The church staff has received a detailed list of responsibilities and target dates that these changes should take place.
- 2. When will the transition be compete? Spring 2015 is the prayerful target.
- 3. When is Pastor Norm retiring? The transition plan never included Pastor Norm retiring. He is simply stepping into a different role at the church.
- 4. What will Pastor Norm do after the transition is complete? He will... Step into a different role at the church, he is not retiring.

Be a shepherd instead of a rancher.

Help hurting sheep instead of herding a large flock.

Comfort lonely mates instead of being CEO for the masses.

Build deeper relationships with a few instead of having surface relationships with a large group.

Be a pastor instead of a promoter and preacher.

Find the one sheep who went astray and bring him home instead of helping 99 who need no help.

Try to grow small groups instead of growing the large group.

Fine tune our Bridge Events to more effectively build a bridge to the unchurched in our community.


Find hurting pastors and put them in an FMC house for weeks or months to help save them and, if possible, their ministry.

Build relationships with real sinners instead of just rallying the saints. Work on learning and remembering the names of adult attenders of FMC.

Pray for, encourage, and support the next lead pastor like never before.



## Project Help of Steuben County

## 711 East Harcourt Road, Angola, across from the YMCA

Project Help is a strategic partner with FMC in helping meet the practical needs of the underresourced people of Steuben County. Even though Pastor Norm is Chairman of the Board of Project Help, Project Help is not a ministry of FMC.

In October 2013, Project Help's food bill at the Community Harvest Food Bank in Fort Wayne was \$7,000. Because Community Harvest Food Bank sells to food pantries at approximately 20 cents on the dollar, that \$7,000 translates into \$35,000 of food at retail prices, all distributed to Steuben County people in one month's time.

After donations of food from many generous organizations in Steuben County, Project Help will still spend approximately \$3,000 to purchase food from the Community Food Bank to provide Thanksgiving meals for underresourced people of our county. Thanksgiving meal distribution is Monday, November 25, 12:00 noon to 4:00 pm. Would you like to help with it? Please call 665-9697 to volunteer.

Hunters have you shot a deer and don't want the meat? You can donate it to Project Help. Here is how: Anstead Butcher Shop, 7245 N 925 E, Fremont, 495-7632, will process it for Project Help. You take the deer there. They are a state licensed check spot too. It costs the hunter nothing to have the deer processed, Hoosiers Feeding the Hungry pays for it all. The deer is processed into ground burger and when Anstead Butcher Shop gets approximately 300 pounds of meat they call Project Help to come pick it up. In short, you shoot, you deliver to Anstead, they process it for Project Help, people get fed and all the processed meat stays in Steuben County.

Christmas help at Project Help is done through underresourced families being "adopted" by others. Adoption lists will be available some time this week. If your small group/small church, etc. would like to adopt a family or several, leave a written note at the Connection Center and someone will contact you in about a week.

We are all getting Christmas catalogues in the mail. Project Help's Christmas catalogue is available in the FMC literature rack across from the mailboxes. Included in the  $8\ 1/2\ x\ 11''$  one sheet black & white brochure is the need for a commercial freezer which costs \$4,000. Thank you for your generous giving.

Project Help is always looking for volunteers - just show up.
