

"GIVE IT ALL AWAY SUNDAY"

Sunday, March 2, 2014, has been designated "Give it all away Sunday" at FMC. That Sunday we are going to give away our entire offering. We are not paying utilities, not paying the mortgage, not even salaries. Instead, the Church Leadership Board has declared it "give it all away Sunday". We are going to give it away globally, nationally, regionally and locally.

Globally - we are going to help fight world poverty by funding the Kids Against Hunger meal packing event. Some of it will go to support our missionaries: George and Karen Bellas in their outreach to the Muslim world, Brian and Susie Zuercher who touch young lives at the Pan American Christian Academy in Brazil, Andy and Cassie Miller in Kiev, Donnie and Melanie Riley as they minister in Liberia and Karl and Rachel Anderson as they begin their ministry in South Sudan.

Nationally - we support the high-energy sports ministry of Uncharted Waters through Anna and Levi Marti located in Colorado Springs, Colorado. A new endeavor this year is our support of Sherin Bellas as she becomes an EDGER working with Navigators at the University of Arizona to invest in the lives of college students. We look forward to supporting the World Leadership Academy of the Missionary Church, which is a 9-month program for 18-24 year olds to enhance their development to be leaders in the marketplace, pews, mission fields and pulpits.

Regionally - We will support Camp Selah, a great Christian camp just north of us, as well as the Gideons who place Bibles in the hotels of our nation. We also indirectly support the pastors of small churches in Northern Indiana through our local District Office.

Locally - Lives are being changed through the ministries of Child Evangelism Fellowship, Compassion Pregnancy Center and Project Help, all of which we will support through this offering. We also support the Christian Campus House at Trine University as they minister to our local college students.

You are encouraged to prayerfully consider a special gift over and above your regular giving that week. Our goal for the offering is \$100,000 which is more than 4 times our weekly average for 2014. Nothing is impossible with God! Thank you for your prayers and generous gift.

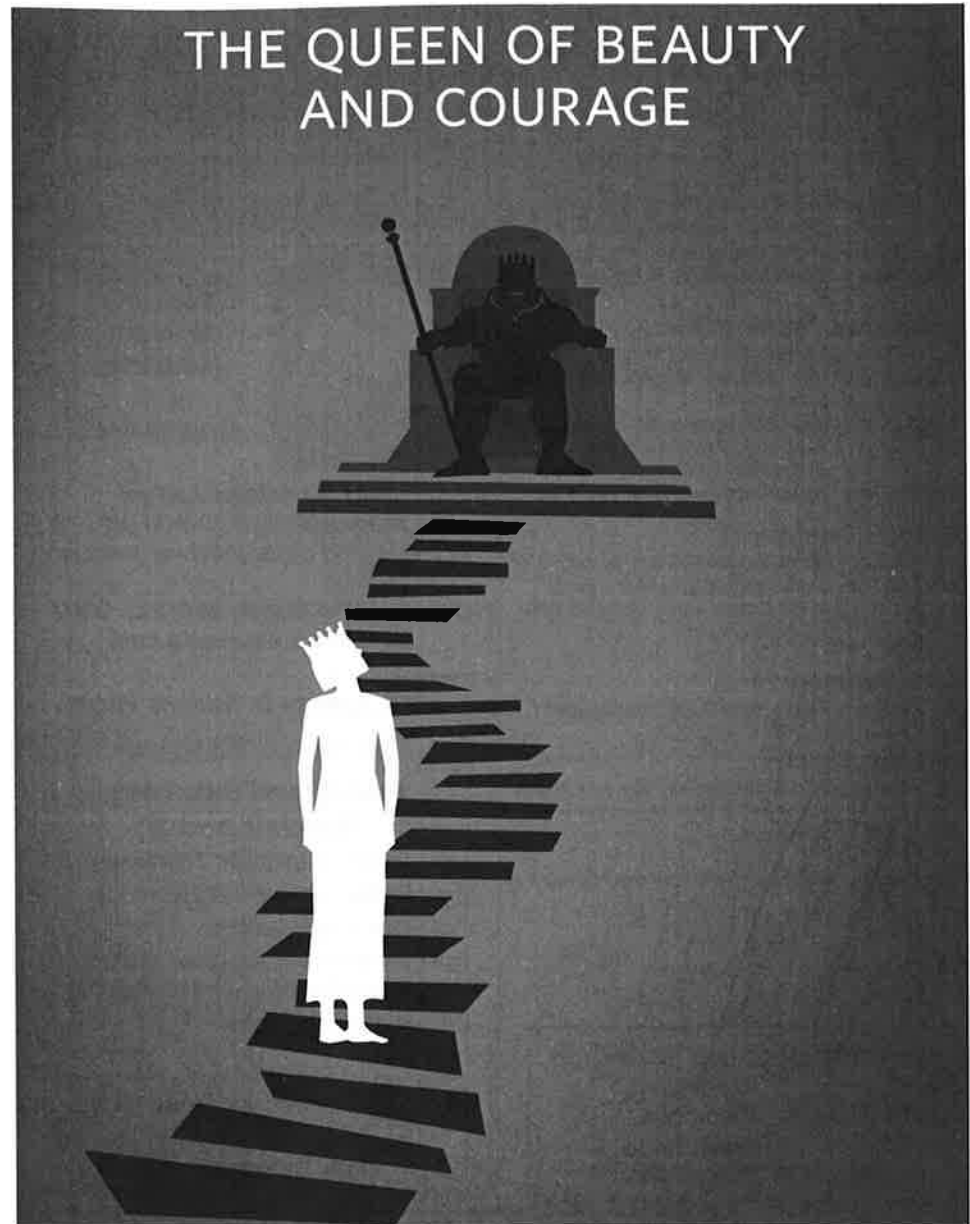

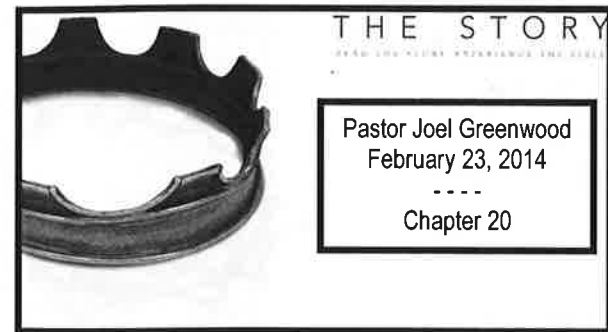
