



#### **Kids Against Hunger 2014**

This year Fairview had the privilege of packing 119,916 nutritious meals for Guatemala. We had 370 volunteers come from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm to pack meals. Approximately 10% of the people were not Fairview attenders and 20% were packing meals for the first time. After four years of packing meals through Kids Against Hunger, FMC has packed a total of 403,520 meals. After the last shift of the meal packing this year, we helped Kids Against Hunger reach their milestone of packing a total of 7 million meals. The meals were sent to Guatemala last week.

Thank you to everyone who contributed their time and money to help make this happen. I am so thankful to have been able to be a part of feeding so many hungry kids.
