

Josh Bleill Indianapolis Colts Community Spokesperson

Marine Corporal Josh Bleill (Bly-ul; rhymes with "Kyle" or "smile") is a native of Greenfield, Indiana. After graduating high school, Josh attended Purdue University. Upon completion of his education, Josh decided to serve his country by joining the United States Marine Corps in 2004 and was activated for a tour of duty in Iraq in 2006.

While serving in Iraq, Corporal Bleill was severely injured, resulting in the loss of both of his legs. After extensive rehabilitation, Bleill returned to Indiana in August of 2008, where he attacked

his new life head-on. This new life included employment as the Indianapolis Colts Community Spokesperson.

Indianapolis Colts Owner, Jim Irsay, has described Bleill as "very talented, bright-eyed and skilled," and Josh now travels the country to spread his message of hope, "one step at a time."



Church Building News

A large portion of the church's roof needs to be replaced. The Trustees have received a bid of \$70,000 to do 23,100 sq. ft., or approximately one half, of the roof. This is the part of the roof that was put on in 1985, 1992, and some in 2000. The bid is from Hydrotech Building Solutions, owned by FMC attender Wade Stiefken. Wade has been in the roofing business for 20 years. The Trustees reviewed the bid carefully and find it to be a very good price for the extensive work and quality of roof being put on. The roof will be an asphalt roof with a 40 year warranty. The goal is to have \$50,000 in hand before they start. Your generous, special gift toward this project is welcome. Like us on Facebook to get daily updates of ministries at FMC!

How you can help invite others to church by sharing and liking FMC Facebook posts.

FMC uses free Facebook as one of its information links to the congregation and community. There are 771 people who like us. We post on Facebook at 7:00 am, 12:00 pm and 5:00 pm because studies show that we are all on Facebook before we start our day,

at lunch break and right after we get home. You might think that all 771 people would have the possibility of seeing what we post each time but that simply is not the case. Facebook determines... with no control by us... who will see our posts. Usually it is a number of around 25 people who are served the initial post. If one of those 25 people like the post it will be shared by Facebook to another 25 or so people, etc. If you share an FMC post on your personal Facebook page then Facebook will (maybe) release our original post to 50 more people, etc. These numbers are just close estimates; therefore, we encourage you to like and share Facebook posts. When you share an FMC post on Facebook, you help grow the church by inviting others!

Some events at the church we pay for Facebook to promote for us and that can change everything about the above. But we prefer the free Facebook.
