

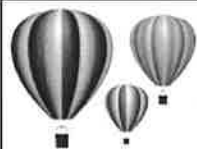

God is doing great things and the next challenge is before us! We will be receiving a special offering to help them launch their third hub for ministry. The goal is that this hub in the southern part of the country will reach three states and be self funded. One of the great possibilities of how this could be self funded is by beginning a new business that sells purified water. There is currently one of these stations where the Rileys live and it does very well. The total cost to start this hub and begin the water filtration process is \$40,000!
