
In the Family...

Church Building News

A large portion of the church's roof needs to be replaced. The Trustees have received a bid of \$70,000 to do 23,100 sq. ft., or approximately one half, of the roof. This is the part of the roof that was put on in 1985, 1992, and some in 2000. The bid is from Hydrotech Building Solutions, owned by FMC attender Wade Stiefken. Wade has been in the roofing business for 20 years. The Trustees reviewed the bid carefully and find it to be a very good price for the extensive work and quality of roof being put on. The roof will be an asphalt roof with a 40 year warranty. The goal is to have \$50,000 in hand before they start. Your generous, special gift toward this project is welcome. Josh Bleill Indianapolis Colts Community Spokesperson

Marine Corporal Josh Bleill (Bly-ul; rhymes with "Kyle" or "smile") is a native of Greenfield, Indiana. After graduating high school, Josh attended Purdue University. Upon completion of his education, Josh decided to serve his country by joining the United States Marine Corps in 2004 and was activated for a tour of duty in Iraq in 2006.

While serving in Iraq, Corporal Bleill was severely injured, resulting in the loss of both of his legs. After extensive rehabilitation, Bleill returned to Indiana in August of 2008, where he attacked

his new life head-on. This new life included employment as the Indianapolis Colts Community Spokesperson.

Indianapolis Colts Owner, Jim Irsay, has described Bleill as "very talented, bright-eyed and skilled," and Josh now travels the country to spread his message of hope, "one step at a time."
