

"Say it again, Pastor"

For ten weeks, beginning August 10, Pastor Norm will be doing a series of messages titled "Say it again, Pastor." These are messages that have been done before at FMC, and in some cases, have been done several times over the years. The series comes from things Pastor Norm feels led to say again to the congregation and from the requests of others who would like certain messages to be repeated. This series leads up to Pastor Norm's and Linda's 40th anniversary as pastors of the church. 40th Anniversary Sunday is October 12, 2014. Special service times that Sunday will be 8:30 and 10:30 a.m. to accommodate the anticipated larger than normal crowd and the 90 minute program.

Next week Pastor Norm begins the above-mentioned series called "Say it again, Pastor". Next week's message is about the altar at the front of the church: Why is it there? When should people come to it? Why is it the most holy spot in the sanctuary? If records are right this message was first given in 1980 in the church on Williams Street and then in 1992 in the old sanctuary. Also, Coral Glenn, who has been at FMC for 50+ years will share about her life journey with the Lord.
