An A-Teams Organization Meeting

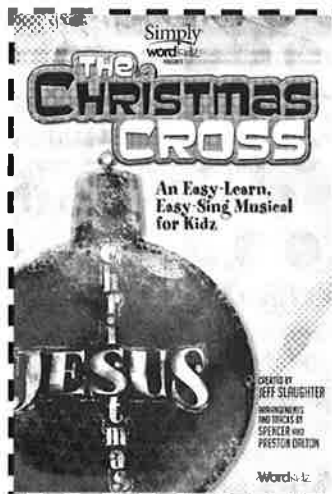
