


Friday October 31 6:00 - 8:00 pm Here at FMC







All the music today was selected by Pastor Norm. The worship songs are ones he likes the best:

- Rock of Ages with Glenn on his harmonica it doesn't get more exciting than this!
- Don't Give Up on the Brink of a Miracle, sung by Beth Stepp, was the song that encouraged the congregation through the two major building projects - 1985-1986 and 1998-2000.
- Pastor Glenn has been the FMC Music Director since 2001.
 Pastor Glenn and Pastor Norm have very similar backgrounds both were raised on farms and both attended small country churches growing up. Glenn's voice leads us to the throne of grace each week!
- Dave Kennedy Dave and Heather and their 3 young children attended FMC 2010-2013. They now live in Coldwater, Ohio. The congregation loved his voice. Pastor Norm invited Dave to return to sing two songs: Day Star and I Want to See Jesus.
- Beth Stepp Beth was volunteer Music Director from 1979, when she and Paul started attending FMC, until 1997 when we hired our first full time Music Director.
- Wayne Mortorff Head Deacon and Chairman of the Church Board. Wayne is speaking on behalf of the congregation.
- District Leaders: FMC is a part of the North Central District of the Missionary Church. The district headquarters is in Elkhart, Indiana. The denomination headquarters is in Fort Wayne, Indiana. FMC is the second largest church in the district and approximately the twelfth largest in the denomination.

Why Did We Stay 40 Years? By Norm and Linda

For a pastor to stay at any church for so long speaks as much about the people in the pew as it does the pastor and his family. The people at FMC have always been very encouraging and supportive of the various challenges and opportunities that come with a growing church. Some personal highlights and thoughts from Pastor Norm and Linda 1974 - 1983

- Our first impression we loved the people! We needed to update the building and solve the water problems. When it rained the parsonage and church basements flooded.
- The little reminders to always reach out to others, such as our stones that had 100 painted on them until we reached 100 people in worship.
- The Bible School parade around the neighborhood to invite kids to Bible School.
- The outdoor Patriotic Service in July each year.
- Remodeling the church we broke the glass out, took John Rupp's tractor and hooked his log chain to the window frames and literally pulled them out.
- The new people God brought in the early 1980s as He prepared us for relocating.
