Sunday: 11:45 am, lunch served for first shift BMP workers; 1-5 pm BMP

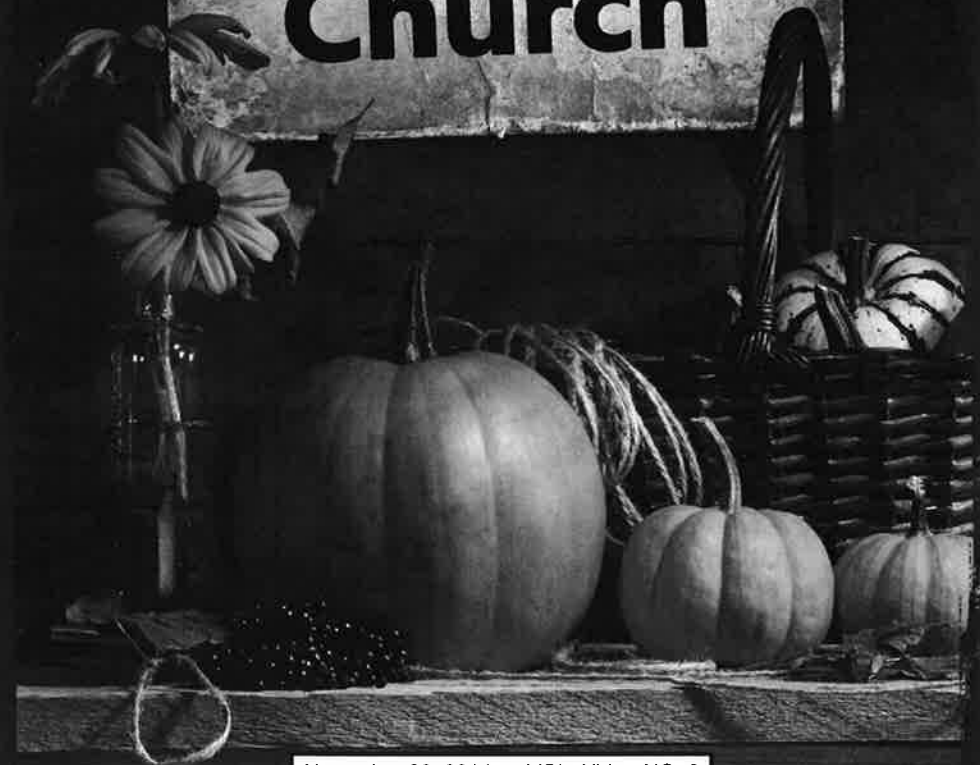
Monday: 8:00 am, tear down BMP, remove sand, clean the whole church

BMP is on the radio in the STAR network, WLKI network of stations in Angola, Sturgis, Archbold and LaGrange. This will make it easy for anyone to invite friends to BMP by making reference to the ad - "did you see the ad?" or "did you hear the ad?" and starting a conversation.

Ads are also placed on Facebook, beyond the normal post. We pay to have an "email blast" sent to approximately 100,000 addresses in northwest Ohio and northeast Indiana. However, the best advertising is still each one of us picking up the literature from the BMP table and personally talking to and inviting our neighbors and friends.

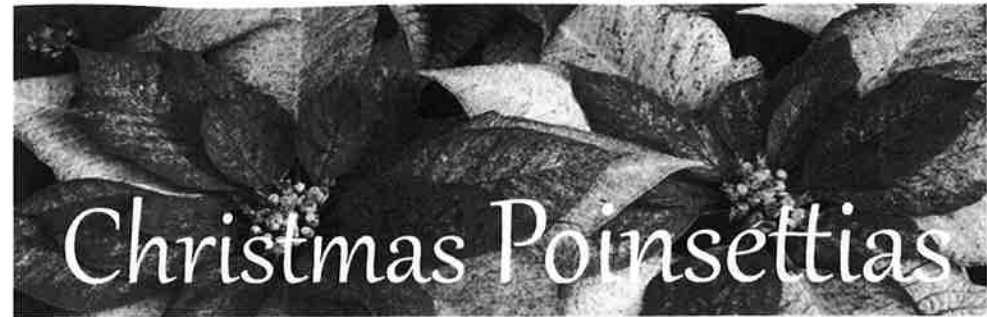
Angel Makers Wanted
