The Colors

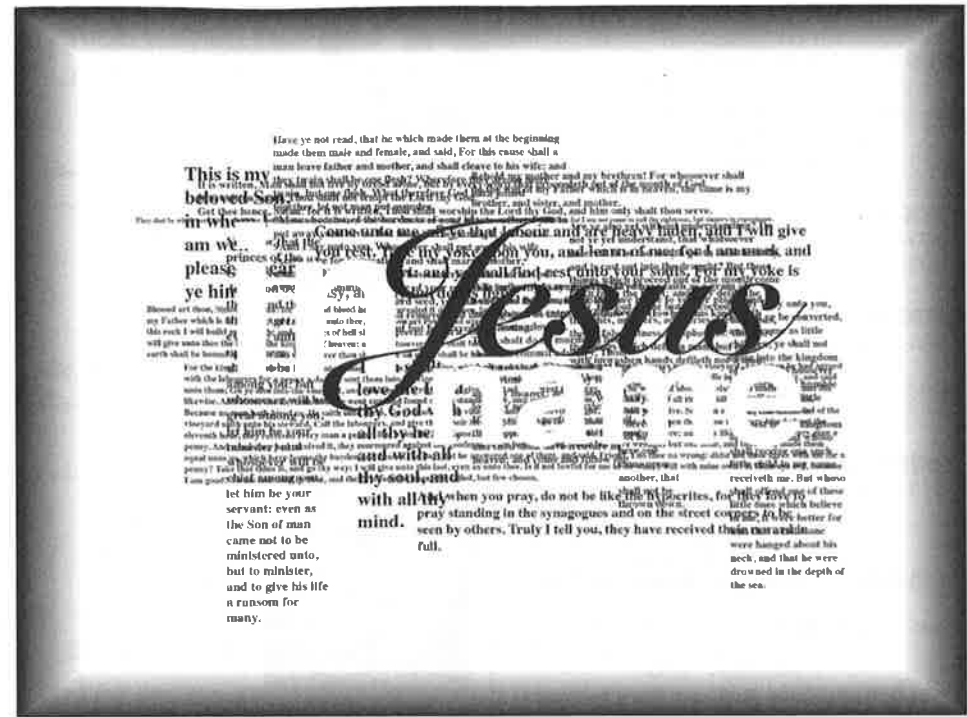
Gold, for the glories of Heaven, only a glimpse here and there.

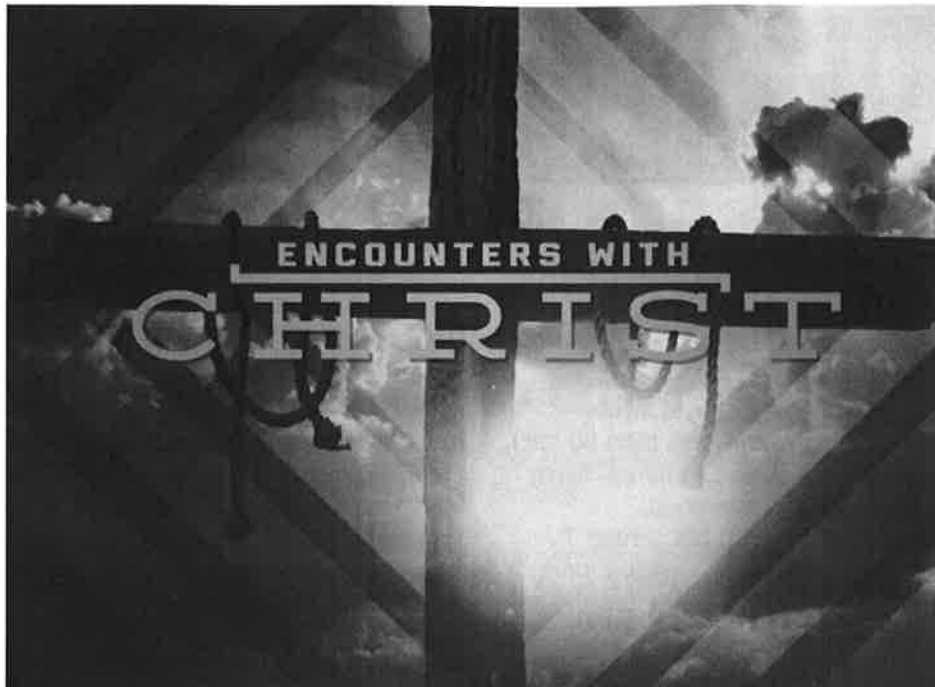

Pastor Joel's Vision Casting Comments from the Annual Business Meeting January 18th, 2015
