


Would you like to be baptized during

Small Churches Answering your questions: and Groups Question: I hear the small churches and sr groups around the ch What is the difference

Question: I hear the terms small churches and small groups around the church. What is the difference?

Answer: Both terms are used to describe our adult ministry for small gatherings. Small churches meet on Sunday mornings at 8:00, 9:00 and 10:30 a.m. Many churches will call this Sunday school. Some small churches meet on Wednesday night during the school year. Many churches call this midweek Bible study. A small church has a primary emphasis on Bible study with a secondary emphasis on social gatherings. Small groups usually meet once a month at various times and locations. Small groups usually have as their primary emphasis, a social gathering with a secondary emphasis on a Bible study or devotional. More about the small church/small group ministry is available in a brochure in the literature rack across from the mailboxes. Look for the brochure, ""Small Churches and Small Groups - What's the Difference?" If you are not in a small group, contact Pastor Norm to get in one. For a small church, pick up the class schedule at the Connection Center.

A 12-15 Month Small Group

A new small group is being formed that will be together for 12-15 months (2 summers?) and then this group will be separated into two or more small groups that will grow and will remain together a long time. The 12-15 month group will be made up of a variety of different people. Singles, married, young couples, mature couples, parents of teens, etc. - limited to 10-15 adults in the meeting each month. 
