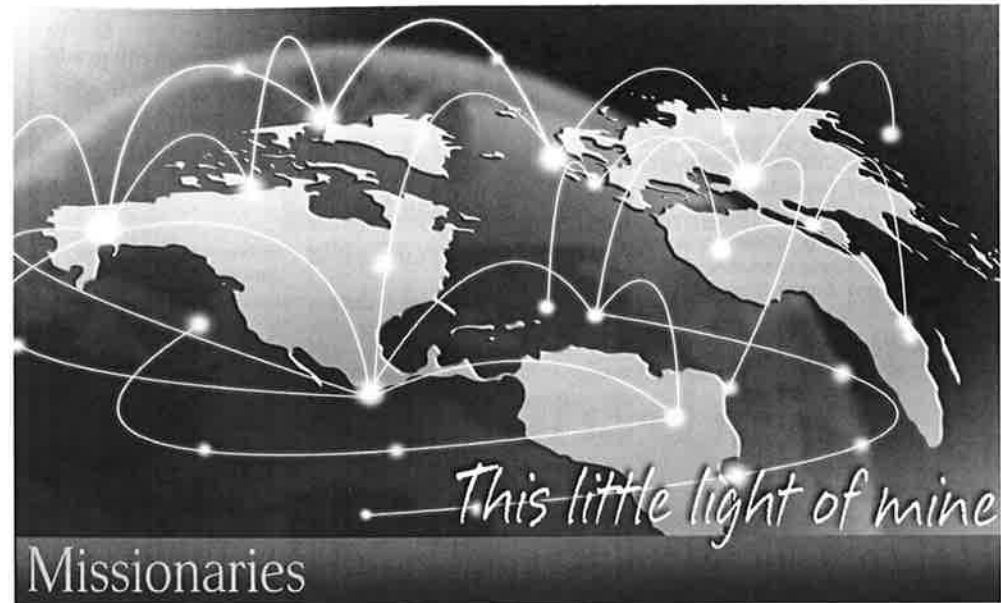
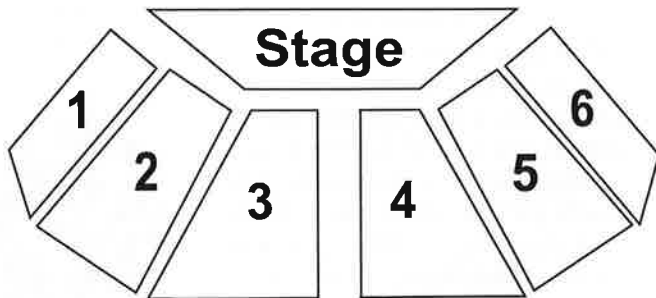


MINGLE UFFINS AND ORE AFTER THE ORNING SERVICES

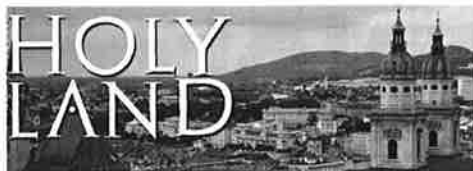

Small Church News!

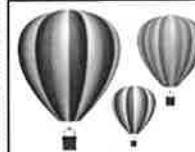
