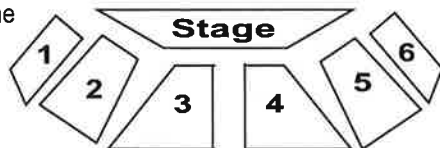

Mingle Muffins and More after the Morning Services

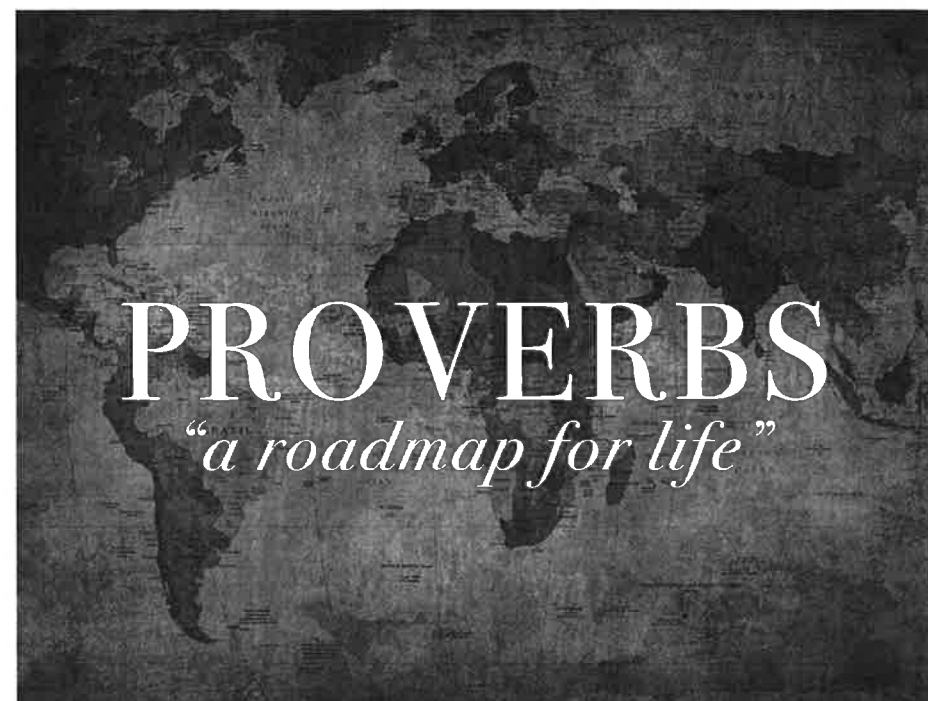
Sundays through August 16. 9:00 attendees mingle in the gym after that service, 10:30 attendees mingle in the gym after the 10:30 service.
