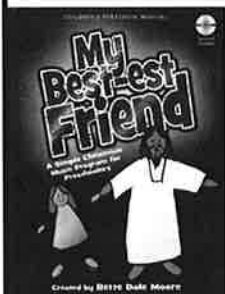


## Operation Christmas Child
