Both men and women are still needed.

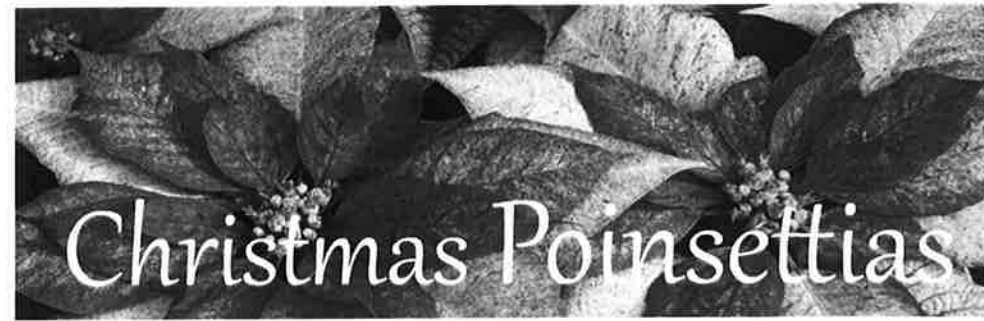
Friday: All day, finishing touches - ladies are especially needed this day!
