This book is by Andy Stanley, pastor at North Point Church in Atlanta, where the series originated. Other churches have done this series. including Pathway Community Church in Fort Wayne, a Missionary Church of 3,000. They did this series in the spring of 2015 and gave us some of their excess materials

This would mean you are hosting a group once a week for four weeks starting the week of February 28 through March 20. Qualifications to be a Host Group Leader are:


- 1. Relationship with Jesus Christ


