

"How to Be Rich", Sunday, February 28 through Sunday, March 20, 2016. Pastor Joel's messages for the four weeks will be "How to Be Rich". All Sunday Small Churches for teens and adults will have a book and DVD teaching that corresponds with the Sunday messages. Special small groups are being formed for four weeks for those not already in a small group or small church. The series culminates with the "Be Rich Offering" where we will give away all our offering to help other ministries in their work to build the Kingdom of God!

Plan now to attend the worship service and an adult small church or small group for the four weeks of February 28 - March 20. The adult classes meet:

Each family will receive a "How to Be Rich" book and reading schedule to use in the small groups/small churches. To encourage "buy in" we suggest a donation of \$1.00 per book. This book is by Andy Stanley, pastor at North Point Church in Atlanta, where the series originated. Other churches have done this series, including Pathway Community Church in Fort Wayne, a Missionary Church of 3,000. They did this series in the spring of 2015 and gave us some of their excess materials

For the "How to Be Rich" series we are seeking couples and singles who would like to be a "Host Group Leader" for the four week series. This would mean you are hosting a group once a week for four weeks starting the week of February 28 through March 20. Qualifications to be a Host Group Leader are:

- 1. Relationship with Jesus Christ
- 2. Friendly
- 3. Hospitable
- 4. TV and DVD Player
- 5. Room to accommodate 2-20 people

The Host Group Leader would also determine:

- 1. Day of week your group meets
- 2. Time
- 3. Number who can sign up
- 4. Location such as Fremont, Angola, Orland
- 5. Kids allowed or not
- 6. Age restrictions (if any)


