Lost and Found Coats

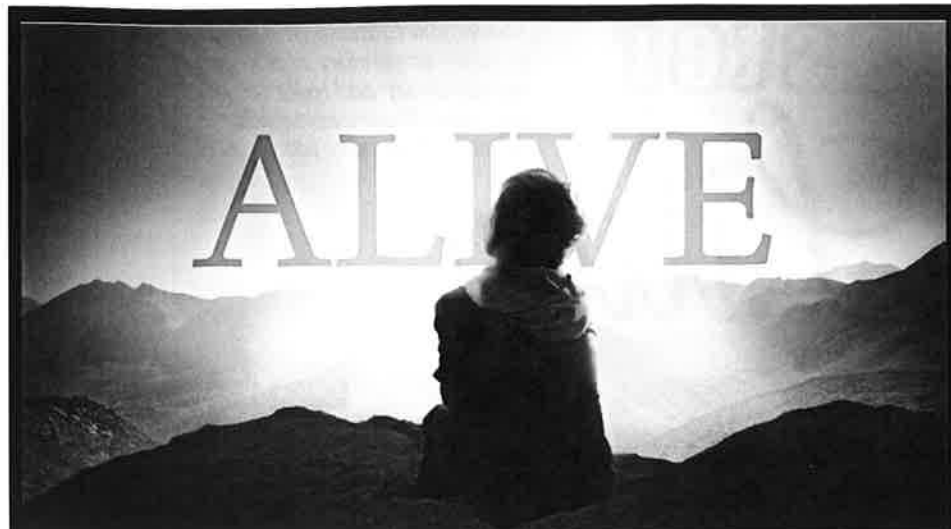
