Cooling the Sanctuary - For your information, the thermostat in the sanctuary is set to cool at 75 degrees. That is what is comfortable for the average person sitting in the seat, listening to the message on Sunday morning. With the lights and full sanctuary on Sundays, the air conditioning comes on even in the winter. The thermostat is very sensitive to a tenth of a degree so the temperature will normally fluctuate between 75 and 75.5 degrees on a high humidity day. In August we may lower it to 74 degrees. The coldest spot in the sanctuary is along the back wall.


