Workshop Presenter: Janice King, Fairview Missionary Church Counselor

Purpose: To grow closer to the Lord Jesus Christ through deepening the personal intimacy of our prayer life

Format: Teaching, helpful handouts, practice time, questions and answers. Discussion of the workshop material is encouraged around the table at lunchtime as well.

Heart-Action-Prayer consists of:

Virtue Prayer: Learning to meditate more deeply throughout the day through the vehicle of the gospel stories, creates new neural networks in the brain by focusing on the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit. God is exalted! Virtue Prayer interestingly correlates with the exciting scientific discovery of the last decade of our brain's ability to create new neural networks and change old habits that bog us down.

Contrition Prayer: A six step process we learn in order to more readily change the "old man" which the apostle Paul describes in the epistles, into the "new man". Jan has been observing people stuck in defeating patterns make consistent progress with Contrition Prayer, including lifelong addictions.

Examination Prayer: This prayer is done in small increments. A grid-matrix is given so that we can examine all aspects of our life in a very thorough way, and then make the necessary changes using Contrition Prayer. The whole purpose of Examination Prayer is to consistently remove blockages to knowing, loving, and serving Christ.



History of Heart-Action-Prayer

There is nothing new in Heart-Action-Prayer, as it is based on the basic principles of scripture that happen to correlate perfectly with true science. Personally, I used to find myself bogged down in prayer with wandering mind or guilt, that is false, after I had confessed my sin. Jesus paid the price! I began using parts of these prayers a year ago, and I have been grateful to experience important breakthroughs in my prayer life.

A former Franciscan Friar, Tom Biesiada, introduced me and several others in our St. Vincent's prayer group to these prayers. Tom believes he is being called to enter into a full-time life of prayer for our country and world. He is gifting us Heart-Action-Prayer with full rights to teach and use this remarkable, life-changing work of many years. He is in Fort Wayne now for a short time, using and teaching Heart-Action-Prayer. Tom will be available for the Saturday, August 6 workshop to offer people who attend an opportunity for individual time with him, to personally experience the power of Contrition Prayer.
