- 5. If someone doesn't understand the trinity and has problems believing in it, but believes all the other essentials, are they not saved? The Bible says, "Confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead and you will be saved." It does not say, "believe in the trinity and you will be saved."
