Small Group Questions

1. Do you feel awkward or even a bit selfish praying for your own personal needs? Why is that? If you believe it is aligned with God's will, would it not be a good thing?

2. How do you explain to someone young in their faith the concept of praying for what you want, but not being guaranteed you will receive what you asked for? (Healing, pain, relief, financial relief...)

3. What kind of things do you pray for other believers? How often do you pray for other brothers and sisters in Christ?

4. When is it (is it ever?) okay to pray for permission to have revenge? (As Samson did)

5. When/if we pray for deliverance, are we actually challenging God's sovereignty? Is it more appropriate to pray for strength, patience, wisdom or faith?
