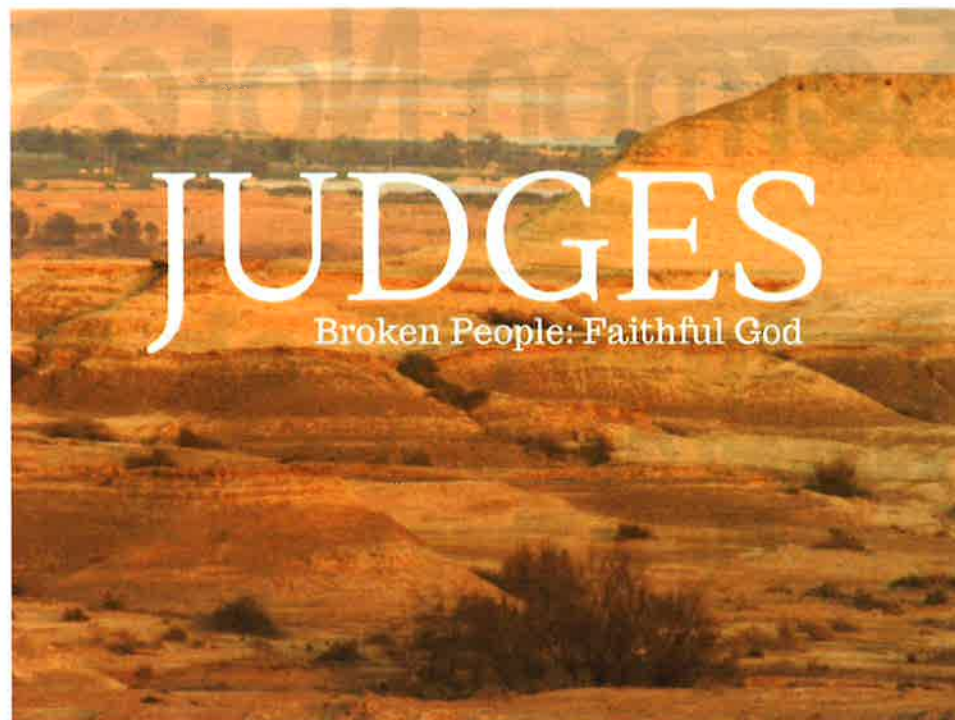
Fairview Cruise-in & Chili Cook-Off
