Small Group Questions

Here are the questions to use in your small group settings this week on week three of series "The End".

1. Why does this account in revelation only have 144,000 people on Gods side?

2. We know that God wins in the end. Can that mindset make us complacent and keep us from advocating for others?

3. We are reminded over and over again in Revelation that the real enemy in our lives is Satan... not those around us or our circumstances. In addition to this reoccurring message is one even greater: Christ has already defeated Satan...we have already won the victory of salvation through Jesus. Does that not change your perspective on things you encounter?

4. Joel shared that the scripture verse - the Shema – was to be tied to the right wrist and forehead of the devout Jew (I believe called flackeries). Does the position of where the sign of the Beast is to be placed now take on a different meaning? Is this a mockery of Christ followers?
