- 4. What relationship, that you are involved in, needs work towards unity and peace? What imperfections that you have contribute to the struggles in your relationships?
- 5. In what relationship am I most challenged in consistently choosing the virtues outlined in Colossians? How am I asking God for help?
- 6. Christians are called to be Christ's ambassadors this is not just for un-believers but also to those we live with. Why is it so difficult to be a godly ambassador in our own home?
- 7. Using a maxim of "A lot more is caught than taught" What practical reminders and nuggets of relationships do you model for your children and spouse as you lead in your own household? Are you willing to change after seeking feedback from those you love?
